Duty to provide information when collecting data

4. Purposes and legal bases of the processing

For your request of the event the following data are collected: company, first name, last name, address, e-mail, telephone number and event period.

The legal basis refers to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b. of the GDPR.

5. Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data

Your personal data which we collect on your request, will not be forwarded to any third parties.

6. Duration of storage of personal data

Your data will be stored as long as it is in §147 Abs.3 AO.

7. Affected rights

According to the General Data Protection Regulation you have the following rights:

If your personal data are processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR).

If incorrect personal data are processed, you are entitled to a correction (Art. 16 DSGVO).

If the legal prerequisites exist, you can request the deletion or limitation of the processing and appeal against the processing (Articles 17, 18 and 21 DSGVO).

If you have consented to the data processing or a data-processing contract is existing and the data processing is carried out using automated procedures you may be entitled to data transferability (article 20 GDPR).

If you make use of your aforementioned rights, the public authority will check whether the legal requirements for this have been met.

Furthermore, there is a right of appeal to the Land Commissioner NRW for data protection.

8. Withdrawal with consent

At any time and without giving reasons, you have the opportunity to object to the processing of your data and to request their deletion.

We will then perform the deletion immediately. If a deletion is not possible due to legal requirements of tax and commercial law, your data will only be processed for the duties arising for us from the law. Processing for commercial purposes does not take place after a contradiction.
